

RESOLUTION NUMBER 17-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA DIRECTING THE TOWN MANAGER TO GIVE NOTICE TO ALL THE TOWN'S UTILITY CUSTOMERS, AS PROVIDED BY LAW, OF A PROPOSED INCREASE IN WATER RATES

WHEREAS: The Town Manager, as director of the Town Utilities, has determined that a rate increase for water services is appropriate and necessary to maintain the system; and

WHEREAS: Such proposals are subject to procedures stated in Town Ordinance 14-06, codified at Chapter 30, Article II of the Town Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Fort Myers Beach, Florida that:

1. The Town Manager, as Director of Town Utilities, has determined that an increase of five percent (5%) in water rates is necessary to maintain the system's fiscal integrity.
2. Pursuant to Florida law, each customer shall be notified of the date, time and place of the public meeting at which said increase will be considered is to be included with each customer's regular billing.
3. The Town Manager shall prepare said notice and so include it in the regular billing to each customer.
4. The date, time and place of the Town Council meeting at which said increase will be considered is: Monday, October 16, 2017 at 9:00 AM or as soon thereafter as it may be heard, at Town Hall, 2525 Estero Blvd., Fort Myers Beach, Florida 33931.

THE FOREGOING RESOLUTION was adopted by the Town Council upon a motion by Council Member Shamp and seconded by Vice Mayor Gore and upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:




