

RESOLUTION NUMBER 22-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF \$2,000 FROM THE FORT MYERS BEACH COMMUNITY FOUNDATION; ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF \$1,000 FROM THE KIWANIS CLUB AND ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF \$18,000 FROM THE FRIENDS OF BAY OAKS; ALLOCATING THE DONATIONS TO HELP FUND TEEN AND YOUTH PROGRAMS, INCLUDING SUMMER CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS AT BAY OAKS AND SUMMER CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS AT THE MOUND HOUSE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes provide that municipalities shall have the governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers to enable them to conduct municipal government, perform municipal functions, and render municipal service, and exercise any power for municipal purposes, except when expressly prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, Article X of the Town Charter of the Town of Fort Myers Beach (“Town”) empowers the Town to adopt, amend, or repeal such ordinances and resolutions as may be required for the proper governing of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Myers Beach Community Foundation wishes to donate \$2,000 to the Town; the Kiwanis Club wishes to donate \$1,000 to the Town, and The Friends of Bay Oaks wishes to donate \$18,000 to the Town (“Donations”); and

WHEREAS, the Town believes it is in the best interest of the Town’s business owners, residents, and visitors to accept the Donation and approve the appropriation of the Donations to help fund teen and youth programs, including summer camp scholarships at Bay Oaks and summer camp scholarships at the Mound House.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct, and incorporated herein by this reference and are hereby adopted as the legislative and administrative findings of the Town Council.

Section 2. The Donations from the Fort Myers Beach Community Foundation, the Kiwanis Club and The Friends of Bay Oaks are accepted and the Town Manager is directed to appropriate the Donations to help fund teen and youth programs, including summer camp scholarships at Bay Oaks and summer camp scholarships at the Mound House

Section 3. If any section or portion of a section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other section or part of this Resolution.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the Town Council upon a motion by Council Member Allers and seconded by Vice Mayor Hosafros, and upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:


