

RESOLUTION NUMBER 23-68

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF \$25,000 FROM 7-ELEVEN FOR BALL FIELD RESTORATION WORK AT BAY OAKS RECREATIONAL CAMPUS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes provide that municipalities shall have the governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers to enable them to conduct municipal government, perform municipal functions, and render municipal service, and exercise any power for municipal purposes, except when expressly prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, Article X of the Town Charter of the Town of Fort Myers Beach (“Town”) empowers the Town to adopt, amend, or repeal such ordinances and resolutions as may be required for the proper governing of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the 7-Eleven is donating \$25,000 towards the restoration of the baseball field at Bay Oaks Recreational Campus (“Donation”); and

WHEREAS, the Town believes it is in the best interest of the Town’s business owners, residents, and visitors to accept the donation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct, and incorporated herein by this reference and are hereby adopted as the legislative and administrative findings of the Town Council.

Section 2. The Donation from 7-Eleven is accepted.

Section 3. If any section or portion of a section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other section or part of this Resolution.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the Town Council upon a motion by Council Member King and seconded by Council Member Woodson, and upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:
