

## **RESOLUTION NUMBER 24-35**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH FLORIDA APPROVING WITH CONDITIONS A SPECIAL EXCEPTION AMENDMENT SEZ20230052, REQUESTING A SIX-MONTH REASSESSMENT OF PREVIOUSLY APPROVED AMENDMENTS TO ALLOW FOR OUTDOOR ALCOHOL SALES AND LIVE MUSIC; PROVIDING FOR CLARIFICATIONS AS NECESSARY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS OF LAW, SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Florida Statutes provide that municipalities shall have the governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers to enable them to conduct municipal government, perform municipal functions, and render municipal service, and exercise any power for municipal purposes, except when expressly prohibited by law; and

**WHEREAS**, Article X of the Town Charter of the Town of Fort Myers Beach empowers the Town to adopt, amend, or repeal such ordinances and resolutions as may be required for the proper governing of the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, 1249 Estero Adventures LLC, owners of the property situated at 1249 Estero Boulevard, is requesting a six-month reassessment of previously approved amendments to allow for outdoor alcohol sales and live music; and

**WHEREAS**, the STRAP number for the subject property is 19-46-24-W4-0060H.0300; and

**WHEREAS**, the Property is located in the "Pedestrian Commercial" category of the Future Land Use Map of the Comprehensive Plan and the "Downtown" zoning district of the Official Zoning Map of the Town of Fort Myers Beach, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing on this matter was legally noticed and held before the Local Planning Agency (LPA) on February 27, 2024, and at said hearing the LPA gave full and complete consideration to the request of Applicant, recommendations of staff, the documents in the file, and the testimony of all interested persons, as required by Section 34-88 of the LDC. The LPA found that the request is consistent with the comprehensive plan and the requirements of the LDC and voted to recommend approval with conditions of the special exception; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 18, 2024, the Town Council held a duly noticed public hearing to fully consider the request of the Applicant, the recommendations of Town staff and the LPA, the documents in the record, and testimony of all interested persons as required by 34-88 of the LDC; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council determined it is in the best interest of the Town to approve with conditions

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The above recitals are true, correct, incorporated herein by this reference, and adopted as the legislative and administrative findings of the Town Council.

Section 2. The Town Council determines the Applicant did meet its burden of proof that the requested Variance does meet the requirements of the Town Comprehensive Plan and LDC and approving with conditions the Special Exception is in the best interest of the Town. Therefore, based upon the recommendations, testimony, and evidence presented by the Applicant, Town staff, interested parties and public, the Town Council APPROVES WITH CONDITIONS a request for an amendment of Town of Fort Myers Beach Special Exception 13-09 allowing for alcohol sales and outdoor music on the subject property.

Section 3. In approving with conditions the Special Exception, the Town Council makes the following findings and conclusions in accordance with the considerations of Section 34-88 of the LDC:

- (1) Whether there exist changed or changing conditions which make approval of the request appropriate.
- (2) The testimony of any applicant.
- (3) The recommendation of staff and of the local planning agency.
- (4) The testimony of the public.
- (5) Whether the request is consistent with the goals, objectives, policies and intent of the Fort Myers Beach Comprehensive Plan.
- (6) Whether the request meets or exceeds all performance and locational standards set forth for the proposed use.
- (7) Whether the request will protect, conserve, or preserve environmentally critical areas and natural resources.
- (8) Whether the request will be compatible with existing or planned uses and not cause damage, hazard, nuisance, or other detriment to persons or property.
- (9) Whether a requested use will be in compliance with applicable general zoning provisions and supplemental regulations pertaining to the use set forth in this chapter.

Section 4. If the Town Council approves the requested special exception amendment, the following conditions of approval are imposed on the Applicant and the Property:

A. Approval of this variance does not give the Applicant an undeniable right to permit approval. Development or redevelopment of the Property must comply with all applicable requirements of the Fort Myers Beach Comprehensive Plan and LDC in effect at the time of permit approval, except as specifically modified herein.

B. The amendment of Conditions of Approval for Res. 13-09 shall be temporary for a period of 6 months from the date of this resolution or until construction of a new building has begun, whichever happens first.

C. Live music is allowed on 1249 Estero Blvd. but drums are not allowed as part of the entertainment.

D. Amplified music is allowed on 1249 Estero Blvd. until 6:30pm Sunday through Thursday, after which amplified music may not be louder than 65-decibels as long as the other conditions of approval are upheld.

E. Amplified music is allowed on 1249 Estero Blvd. Friday and Saturday and will be controlled by the Town's noise ordinance (LDC sec. 14-23; Table-1), as long as the other conditions of approval are upheld.

F. Town Council is waiving application fees for the next 6 month review of the approved special exception amendment.

G. The variance shall only apply to the lot as shown on the provided site plan.

The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the Town Council upon a motion by Mayor Allers and seconded by Council Member King, and upon being put to a roll call vote, the result was as follows:
