Town of Fort Myers Beach provides an update on the FEMA National Flood Insurance Program

Town of Fort Myers Beach, FL – The Town of Fort Myers Beach submitted all required documentation identified by FEMA on Tuesday, May 21, 2024. Town staff are awaiting review of the documentation by FEMA. It is anticipated that the review period will take 30 days from the deadline given to all municipalities to submit, which is June 10, 2024.

The Town of Fort Myers Beach staff and Council are committed to maintaining our CRS rating of a 5 to ensure our residents are eligible for flood insurance discounts.
