FEMA announces the Town of Fort Myers Beach will be removed from probation under the NFIP!

Town of Fort Myers Beach, FL – Today, April 28, 2025, FEMA announced the Town of Fort Myers Beach has met the requirements to be removed from probation under the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), effective November 18, 2025!

The Town accomplished the five action items set forth by FEMA, which will remove us from probation and will end the \$50 surcharge that was added to all NFIP policies within the Town limits on November 18, 2024.

Thank you to Congressman Byron Donalds, Senator Rick Scott, Senator Ashley Moody, and our partners at FEMA for working with the Town to make this possible! We look forward to continuing our working relationship to further improve our floodplain management practices.

The Town of Fort Myers Beach is on Estero Island off the southwest Florida coast of the Gulf of Mexico. The beach stretches for seven miles and is known for white sand, shell finds, and sunsets. The Town took a direct hit in September 2022 from Hurricane Ian, a category five storm, and is in active recovery. Many shops and restaurants are restored and open for business! The Town has been incorporated since 1995.
