A Message from Town Manager Will McKannay

Town of Fort Myers Beach, FL – As of September 23, 2025, the current provision allowing permits for trailers and RVs will expire. This is part of the Town’s effort to comply with FEMA regulations and restore its standing in the National Flood Insurance Program.

Finding a compliant path forward is deeply important to me—not just as a matter of policy, but as a personal mission to support our residents and businesses in their recovery. I am working closely with our elected leaders, my staff, and FEMA representatives to identify a solution that protects this vital resource while ensuring full alignment with floodplain management standards.

Our community has come too far, and although I cannot yet promise success in this effort, I will pursue this goal relentlessly until we have exhausted all efforts.

The Town of Fort Myers Beach is on Estero Island off the southwest Florida coast of the Gulf of Mexico. The beach stretches for seven miles and is known for white sand, shell finds, and sunsets. The Town took a direct hit in September 2022 from Hurricane Ian, a category five storm, and is in active recovery. Many shops and restaurants are restored and open for business! The Town has been incorporated since 1995.
