

RESOLUTION NUMBER 25-325

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING A YEAR-END BUDGET ADJUSTMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; RATIFYING A \$403.00 INCREASE IN THE NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT FROM \$120,778.00 to \$121,181.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN ALUMINUM BOAT FROM SCULLY'S ALUMINUM BOATS, INC; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes provide that municipalities shall have the governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers to enable them to conduct municipal government, perform municipal functions, and render municipal service, and exercise any power for municipal purposes, except when expressly prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, Article X of the Town Charter of the Town of Fort Myers Beach ("Town") empowers the Town to adopt, amend, or repeal such ordinances and resolutions as may be required for the proper governing of the Town; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes s. 200.065 establishes the method for adoption of a budget for all taxing authorities in the State of Florida and Florida Statutes s. 166.241 requires the governing body of each municipality in Florida to adopt a budget via ordinance or resolution before the start of each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2024, the Town Council of the Town of Fort Myers Beach, following due public notice, adopted a final operating budget for fiscal year 2024-2025, as set forth with greater specificity in Town Resolution 24-185; and

WHEREAS, Section 11.05 (d) of Article XI of the Charter of the Town of Fort Myers Beach provides that at any time during the fiscal year, the town manager may transfer any unencumbered appropriations among programs within a department, office, agency or a program provided by inter local agreement and, upon written request by the town manager, the council may by resolution transfer between funds any unencumbered appropriations from one department, office, agency or a program provided by inter local agreement to another; and

WHEREAS, the Town collected an unbudgeted Code Enforcement Lien of \$725,840.00 in November 2024; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that the purchase of a new aluminum boat in the amount of \$121,181.00 to service the Mooring Field, Maritime and Code Enforcement operations was in the best interest of the town; and

WHEREAS, an adjustment to Fiscal Year 2025 budget to recognize the funding of the purchase of this boat is deemed appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of the boat was authorized by the Town Council via Resolution 25-91 on June 16, 2025, for a not-to-exceed amount of \$120,778.00, after which an additional expenditure of \$403.00 was deemed necessary to fully equip the boat.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Town Council of Fort Myers Beach, Florida as follows.

Section 1. The above recitals as set forth in the various “Whereas” clauses are hereby adopted by reference and incorporated into the body of this Resolution.

Section 2. The Town Council further finds that the supplemental appropriation of funds is as provided in this Section consistent with the requirements of Section 11.05 (d) of Article XI of the Town Charter, and hereby approves, adopts, and accepts the following budget amendment:

Section 3. The Town Council hereby ratifies the \$403.00 increase of the not-to-exceed amount from \$120,778.00 to \$121,181.00 for the purchase of the boat from Scully’s Aluminum Boats.

Section 4. This resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.
